### **More Big-League Law Firms Put Private Eyes on the Case**

..."Mintz Group's expertise in computer research helped Donald F. Luke find what he needed to eviscerate a lawsuit one of his clients was facing. The bank had been sued by a German citizen for refusing to redeem bonds that it contended were stolen. The private investigator searched computerized court records and learned that the plaintiff had an arrest warrant outstanding in the U.S. So Mr. Luke, a partner in the new York firm Rogers & Wells, insisted that the German had to come to the U.S. to give his deposition. 'He didn't show up,' Mr. Luke says, and the case was dismissed."
